## Why to change the Standing List System ?

- Only a little number of competitions within one year
  - We want to increase the number of enumerable competitions
  
- Bad weather conditions result in bad results
  - The winner get a fixed number of points regardless the cable is difficult or the weather condition is weak
  
- High cost for organizer because of huge number of judges
  - We reduce the technical requirements and number of judges for homologated competitions
  
- Big workload for organizers due to homologation requirements
  - We create a new low ,Who-beat-who‘ homologation

## Comparisation of Standing-List vs. Who-Beat-Who

## How does the Who-Beat-Who system works ?

- Skiers will receive points based on the placement, not based on the result
- We will start in 2015 to give WBW points for place 1-60 (each discipline)
  - 1000 points for place 1
  - 1 point for place 60
- To differ between the competitions some coefficient factors are added:
  - Factor 1 : Important (Title event) or not important competition (Local)
  - Factor 2 : Best ranked skiers participating at competition or not
- We will use the WBW list to nominate the specialists for the titled events from 2016 on. For the 2015 E&A Open the 2014 Ranking List will be used.
- The closing date for the nomination of the specialists need to be defined

## Factors respecting different competitions

| Factor 1 | Competition Type                      |
|----------|---------------------------------------|
| 1,00     | Worlds / E&A Open / World Cup         |
| 0,90     | E&A Junior / Senior                   |
| 0,80     | International homologated (RC or N)   |
| 0,70     | International small homologated (WBW) |
| 0,60     | National homologated (RC or N)        |
| 0,50     | National small homologated (WBW)      |

## Factors respecting different competitions

| Factor 2 | Skiers participating at competition |
|----------|-------------------------------------|
| 1,00     | Minimum 4 skiers in best 15         |
| 0,85     | Minimum 9 skiers in best 30         |
| 0,70     | Minimum 15 skiers in best 60        |
| 0,59     | Minimum 14 skiers in best 60        |
| 0,50     | Minimum 13 skiers in best 60        |
| 0,43     | Minimum 12 skiers in best 60        |
| 0,37     | Minimum 11 skiers in best 60        |
| 0,32     | Minimum 10 skiers in best 60        |
| 0,28     | Minimum 9 skiers in best 60         |

| Factor 2 | Skiers participating at competition |

| 0,24     | Minimum 8 skiers in best 60         |
| 0,21     | Minimum 7 skiers in best 60         |
| 0,19     | Minimum 6 skiers in best 60         |
| 0,17     | Minimum 5 skiers in best 60         |

| 0,13     | Minimum 3 skiers in best 60         |
| 0,12     | Minimum 2 skiers in best 60         |

## Calculation 1/2

- The winner of each category (Open ; U-19 ; U-15, Sen) will receive 1000 pts
- If a skiers want to receive points in Open category he must ski in Open cat.
- Every skiers can only sum up the best 5 scores of competitions within the last 365 days
- There is a maximum of 2 scores per site
- Based on the categories we will have different WBW rankings :
  - WBW-Open
  - WBW-19
  - WBW-15
  - WBW-Senior
- Individuals (Specialists) for E&A Open will be choosen from WBW-open only



## Calculation 2/2

$$\text{WBW Points} = \text{Points} \times \text{Factor}_1 \times \text{Factor}_2$$

Example 1 : Winner of World Championship, with RC homologation  
and the best skiers are present

$$1000 \times 1,0 \times 1,0 = 1000 \text{ Points}$$

Example 2 : Third Place at international competition with WBW homologation  
and 10 best skiers (out of 60) are present

$$828 \times 0,7 \times 0,32 = 185 \text{ Points}$$
